#### 4) **Public Participation:**

A further presentation was given by the History Group (BH) regarding funding for St Agatha's Cob Wall restoration. Quotes had been obtained from a Thatcher and a Cobb Wall specialist. These figures cumulatively came in at £17,500.00. A request was made for Parish Council funding towards this cost. It was explained that the History Group are going to set up a Just Giving page, apply for grants from SODC (application is currently in progress) as well as £500.00 from the Grant Community Association. It was also proposed to involve local residents and school children (as a learning opportunity).

All of the Councillors agreed that this was a good cause to preserve this very historic part of the Cobb Wall at St Agatha's Church Yard. Currently, the Parish Council have proposed that they could offer some funds but, have requested, in the first instance, that the Just Giving Page be set up to start donations and to see if there are any other ways of obtaining further Grants. It was proposed that if all of the above could be put in place then, a review can then take place with the Parish Council regarding additional funding towards this from the Parish Council Grant Fund and also with consideration of CIL Funding (as a one of payment)

This will be revisited/reviewed.


